



Erasmus⁺ with partner countries

The programme has as main purpose the development of bilateral mobility between universities from Europe and other partner countries with the financial support of the European Commission/Union.

Types of mobility that will be available:

Study mobility

- Bilateral mobility between universities from Azerbaijan and Romania for a period that can be between 3 months and 10 months;
- A period of 4.5 months to 5 months is recommended for the mobility;
- Only students that are enrolled at one of the universities can participate in the program;
- The students can only be selected for the academic fields mentioned in the bilateral agreements;
- The scholarship will be paid by Babeş-Bolyai University, from the Erasmus grant, after the arrival of the students in Romania;
- The selection of the students is made by the home university and is validated by the host university;
- The exact amount awarded as scholarship will be established once the call is launched at national level (the students have to sustain the difference);
- The host university has to waive tuition fees and cannot ask students for any other fees;
- The study mobility has to be recognised at the home university based on the academic plan approved in the Learning Agreement;
- At the end of the mobility the student will receive the following: the certificate of attendance, the learning agreement (which will contain the exact courses and the number of credits), the transcript of records. The student also has to fill in a final report send by EACEA.
- The scholarship will cover transport and a grant of 750 EUR/month for incoming students in Romania, and 650 EUR/month for outgoing students from Romania;

Internships for students

- Are not available for financing until the academic year 2016/2017;
- They will include mobility for students as internships in universities, NGOs or private enterprises;
- The students' internships can be organised between 3-10 months;
- The selection of the student is made by the home university and is validated by the host university/enterprise;
- The exact amount awarded as scholarship will be established once the call is launched at national level;



- Before the mobility the student will need to fill in an application form at the host university, which also includes an accommodation form, and must receive an invitation letter as confirmation of mobility;
- At the end of the mobility the student will receive the following: the certificate of attendance, and the training agreement (which will contain the exact activities done during the internship). The student will also have to fill in a final report send by EACEA.

Teaching mobility

- The minimum teaching hours will be 8 for each week of mobility;
- The teachers are eligible to participate if they are permanent academic staff at the home university;
- It is recommended to have 1-2 weeks teaching mobility, taking into consideration that the number of weeks funded are quite limited, especially in the first year;
- The teachers are selected at the home university, but the host university has to validate the following: the academic teaching plan, the period, the number of hours and the selected teacher;
- At the end of mobility the teacher will receive: the certificate of attendance, and the teaching plan. The teacher will also have to fill in a final report send by EACEA.
- The scholarship will cover transport and a grant of 140 EUR/day for incoming teachers in Romania, and 160 EUR/day for outgoing teachers from Romania;

Academic staff training

- Both teachers and administrative staff are eligible to participate in staff training mobility;
- The teachers are eligible to participate if they are permanent academic staff at the home university;
- It is recommended to have 1-2 weeks staff training, taking into consideration that the number of weeks funded are quite limited, especially in the first year;
- The teachers are selected at the home university but the host university has to validate the following: the academic teaching plan, the period, the number of hours and the selected teacher or administrative staff member;
- At the end of mobility the academic and administrative staff member will receive: the certificate of attendance, and the training agreement (which will contain the exact activities done during the internship). They will also have to fill in a final report send by EACEA.
- The scholarship will cover transport and a grant of 140 EUR/day for incoming academic staff in Romania, and 160 EUR/day for outgoing academic staff from Romania;



The bilateral agreement condition:

- The bilateral agreement can be signed until 2020, but each year the home and host universities will establish the exact number of beneficiaries, which can be lower than the one mentioned in the bilateral agreement, but not higher;
- The fields of study have to be established in the bilateral agreement and have to be respected while selecting the beneficiaries;
- The bilateral agreement must be signed until January 30th 2015, as it needs to be attached to the application form sent to the National Agency in Bucharest for obtaining the grant;
- The bilateral agreement can be terminated at the request of one of the partners, starting with the next academic year;
- The format of the bilateral agreement is set at European level and cannot be changed, as it represents one of the mandatory requirements to obtain the grant;
- Most of the fields of study have a special code established at European level and this has to be mentioned in the bilateral agreement;
- The language level requirement is set in the bilateral agreement taking into consideration that the form applies for all countries eligible in the program, which do not have English as native language.
