Housing

On-Campus Residence Halls

\$ 3,988 (double) - \$4,535 (single). Students living in on-campus Residence Halls must purchase a meal plan.

Leadership House (must be enrolled at SUNY Cortland for at least 2 semesters Fall and Spring)

\$3,650 (single room) - will share the house with 10 other students and are not required to purchase a meal plan.

West Campus Apartments

\$3,980 (Private room). Students living at West Campus are not required to purchase a meal plan, but can buy it.

Meal Plans

Meals can be eaten at Neubig/Bistro Dining Center where you can have all-you-care-to-eat of any of the variety of foods offered (best value). Meals can also be eaten at any of our twelve other unique dining locations on-campus.

The following dollar amounts have been determined as a Meal Equivalent at our other dining facilities:

Breakfast	\$5.75 (7:30 am – 10:30 am)
Lunch	\$7.00 (10:30 am – 3:00 pm)
Dinner	\$8.75 (4:00 pm – 8:00 pm)

If you purchase above the dollar amount for the Meal Equivalent, you may use your Dragon Dollars to make up the difference. If you have visitors to campus you may use your guest passes.

Commuter Plans: (available to West Campus Students only)

\$1,210 Olympic : 100 meals per semester (approx 6.5 meals per week), \$450 Dining Dollars, 5 Guest Passes

\$980 Collegiate: 75 meals per semester (approx 5 meals per week), \$400 Dining Dollars, 5 Guest Passes

\$720 Recreational: 50 meals per semester (approx 3 meals per week), \$350 Dining Dollars, 5 Guest Passes

Connections Account

All Students Need A Connections Account all laundry machines in all on-campus housing and West Campus can be used ONLY with an ID card that has a Connections account (no coins). The account can also be used for purchases at the College Bookstore, Campus Corner grocery store, dining facilities, copy/print services and in vending machines.

A minimum of \$25 is needed to open this account. Any amount may then be added at any time.
