Most Erasmus+ students are accommodated in “Iulia Haşdeu” Student Campus.

The “Iulia Haşdeu” Student Dorms A1 (~50 EUR/month) have double occupancy rooms with the following facilities:

-  bathroom;
-  furniture;
-  free Internet access.



There is a kitchen on each floor open between 7.00 and 23.00 each day.

Due to the great number of students that apply and the limited places allotted, other dormitories are also taken into consideration, such as **Dormitory 17** or **Dormitory 14** (, ~ 40 EUR/month, double occupancy, bathroom and kitchen on each floor, free internet access).

Particularly Erasmus+ students who come to study at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration and at the Faculty of Political, Communication and Administrative Sciences will be placed in the two dormitories of **Campus Economica (~50 EUR/month)**. There are three people in a room, and:

- bathroom;
- furniture;
- free Internet access.

Check-in and Check-out

There is a separate administration for each dormitory, and the working hours are from Monday to Friday between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. **PLEASE NOTE YOU CAN ONLY CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT DURING THIS INTERVAL!**

For checking in, you should present an ID card (European Students) or the passport (Non-European) in original, a photocopy of the ID or passport, a small photo for the ID accommodation card. At arrival, you will have to sign the rental contract and pay the rent for the first month of accommodation. The administrator will give you the room key and the ID accommodation card. You are kindly asked to respect the accommodation contract!

- Do not forget to check out before your departure to avoid extra costs! Please note you can only stay in the dormitory 2 days after the end of the semester/academic year!

House Rules

- Since you are accommodated in the same dormitory with PhD candidates, you are requested not to organize any parties either in your room or the common areas! Please note **ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED IN ANY OF OUR DORMITORIES!**
- Do not use the fire extinguisher for other purposes than for what it was created.
- Do not make barbeques on the balcony.
- You cannot change your room or dormitory. There are many projects happening at UBB at the same time so all rooms have been carefully assigned.

- You do not have to bring bed linen, the Administration will provide bed sheets, blankets, pillows. The bed linen is changed every Wednesday, between 8:00-10:00 o'clock, you have to go to the administrator to hand in the dirty bed linen and receive a clean one. Do not leave the bed linen on the floor in front of your room; no one will pick it up.

Important

Erasmus+ students who are interested in booking a room in the student dorm should fill in the Student Accommodation Request Form and send it as soon as possible by e-mail to ilona.dranca@ubbcluj.ro

The applications greatly outnumber the accommodation capacities of the university. Therefore, you must apply early for a place and specify the exact date of arrival and departure.

- You cannot ask for a prolongation of stay from the first semester to one year.
- Once you quit the dormitory, you cannot ask to be accommodated again at a later time.
