



FITNESS ROOM HAȘDEU CAMPUS


Located in the **basement of Dormitory 16**, the fitness room is equipped with the latest generation equipment and is available free of charge for all residents.





UNIVERSITY SPORTS PARK "PROF. DR. IULIU HAŢIEGANU"

(formerly known as "Babeş" Park)

One of the largest and most iconic green spaces in Cluj-Napoca, the park also serves as the campus of the Faculty of Physical Education and Sport at Babeş-Bolyai University.

Situated along the Someş River in the western part of the city, it spans 25 hectares, with approximately two thirds dedicated to landscaped green areas including tree-lined alleys, open lawns, flower beds, and wooded zones.



House Rules at a Glance



Use of Rooms & Common Areas

- Rooms are for students only; subleasing, visitors, and commercial activities are not allowed.
- · Pets are not allowed.
- No parties, gambling, alcohol, drugs, or psychotropic substances anywhere in the dorm.
- Do not change locks on doors.
- Do not modify rooms, installations, or common areas without permission.
- Window sills cannot be used for food or hanging clothes.
- Keep rooms and common areas clean; garbage must be disposed of in designated areas.
- Access to laundry services is allowed under specific rules.

Check-In & Check-Out

- Follow check-in and check-out schedules during working hours.
- Return keys and complete the checkout procedure before moving out.
- Remove all personal belongings when leaving; items left behind will be disposed of after 5 days.
- Students who are no longer enrolled must vacate their rooms immediately.
- Extensions require an application, depend on space availability, and consider previous conduct (students with two or more violations may not be allowed to extend).

General Conduct & Updates

- Respect other tenants and dorm administrators.
- Always check the dorm notice board for useful information.
- Read your tenancy contract carefully to understand your rights and obligations.
- Violations will be communicated in writing; penalties are specified in the contract.

Payments & Responsibilities

- Monthly rent must be paid according to the tenancy contract; delays may lead to eviction.
- All damages must be covered by the tenant.
- Notify the dorm administrator about any maintenance needs or malfunctions.

DORM SELECTION & ROOM ASSIGNMENTS

- We have dedicated places for foreign students in several dorms. Dorms change each academic year, and you cannot choose or change your dorm, room, or roommate during the year.
- Starting your second year, you may request a specific dorm via the electronic accommodation form. Requests are subject to availability.
- Only some dorms stay open during summer. If you want to spend the summer in Cluj-Napoca, you can apply for summer accommodation.
- Summer accommodation is available only to certain international student categories. Contact the Centre for International Cooperation to check if your status qualifies.
- If accepted, you might be placed in a different dorm for the summer period.



KEYS & LOCKOUTS

- Your dormitory card is required to enter the dorm, so make sure to carry it with you at all times.
- Remember: your room key and access card are important – keep them safe!
- Lost your key? Don't worry, the dorm administrator will help you replace it during working hours.

CLEANING



Your Room

- Keep your room tidy.
- Take out the garbage regularly.
- Agree on a cleaning rota with your flatmates in the first days
 it makes life much easier.

Shared Spaces

- Corridors and exterior areas are maintained by the university.
- Everyone is expected to contribute to keeping kitchens, bathrooms, and lounges clean.

Appliances

- Wipe down cooking appliances after each use.
- Clean counters and sinks to avoid pests and unpleasant smells.
- Keeping appliances clean also prevents smoke alarms from going off.

BINS & RECYCLING



- Please take out your garbage daily- this keeps your room fresh and the dorm clean for everyone.
- To live more sustainably, please use the recycling bins provided for paper, cardboard, cans, and plastics.



SOCKETS



- Romania uses 220V sockets.
- Use a good quality adapter for your electronics.
- Do not overload sockets; unplug items if you see sparks or smell burning.

SECURITY ON CAMPUS



- Your safety is a top priority. All University accommodations follow strict health, safety, and maintenance regulations.
- The Security Team is available 24/7. In case of an emergency or urgent issue, you need to contact them immediately.

BED LINEN



- Bed linen should be changed weekly (free of charge).
- Take your full set of used linen to the administrator's office during the scheduled times posted on the dorm notice board.

STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES



- General medical consultations are available at the UBB medical offices.
- Dental consultations are available free of charge for Babeş-Bolyai University students at the Sport XXI dormitory (ground floor), located in "Iuliu Haţieganu" Park, 7 Pandurilor Street. Please bring your up-to-date student card.

- Medical emergencies: go to the Emergency Reception Unit at 1–3 Clinicilor Street, contact specialized clinics in Cluj-Napoca, or call 112 immediately.
