Mandarin Training Center (MTC)

Semester Program

- Non-Chinese-speaking exchange students are eligible to take “semester program” (group class) for up to **6 hours per week** without tuition.
- For students who want to take courses other than “semester program” or more than 6 hours per week, extra tuition will be charged (with discount).
- **“Record of Study”** will be provided when reaches course requirements.
(* Not compulsory, no credit provided).



Course Features

- Taught by experienced teachers.
- Small class of 20 students, meet twice per week.
- Class levels range from beginner to advanced.
- On-line placement test.

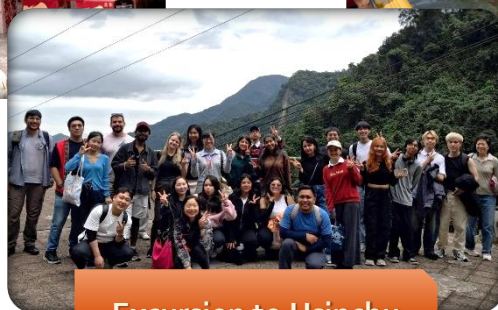

Supports and Campus Life

- Emergency support and assistance (student advisors)

Eligibility

- Nominated full-time students
- Open for undergraduate and graduate.
- Must have completed at least 1 year of enrollment at home university (of same degree) before participate in exchange program.
- All nominees will be gone through a screening process, the admission is not guaranteed.

Accommodation & Other Information

On-Campus Accommodation (*not guaranteed due to limited places*)

Dormitory No. 2 (Gongguan Campus)

- On-campus Dormitory located at Gongguan Campus (approx. 15mins by bus)
- Convenient transportation, safe neighborhood, and easy access to daily necessities.
- Well-equipped facilities:
 - In-room: beds, desks, closets, air-conditioner
 - Public Space: toilets, shower rooms, laundry place, lounge, kitchenette (microwave, rice cooker, oven, induction stove)
- Whole building Wi-Fi coverage, wired network also available
- Residents need to prepare bedding sets by themselves
- Types & Fees
 - Room Type: 4-person Room
 - Rent: TWD 18,000 (approx. USD 580)(per semester/per person)(subject to change)

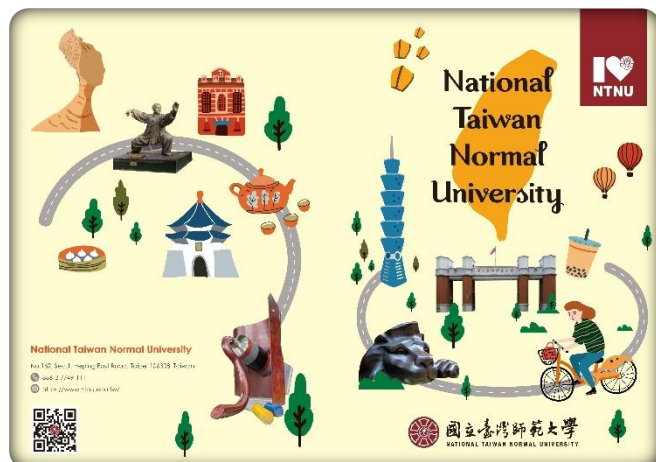


Visa, Insurance, and Living Costs

Insurance	● Both overseas Accidental & Medical Insurance are required. ● Each kind of insurance shall worth a minimum of TWD 1,000,000 (approx. USD 32,500*) valid for the entire exchange period. * subject to the actual exchange rate ● (for One-Academic-Year Exchange Students only) From the 7th month of the stay, students are required to join National Health Insurance (NHI) of Taiwan according to the laws.
