Areas of study open to international students	There are no restrictions for most courses. Students must fill out UFMG's Study Plan, indicating which courses and/or activities they wish to attend at UFMG. Study Plans will then be evaluated by the course coordinators and afterwards the candidates will be informed about their acceptance. It is important to mention that the Faculty of Medicine at UFMG is undergoing changes in the curriculum (as required by the Ministry of Education). Therefore, each request for mobility exchange will be analyzed by the course Collegiate, as there are subjects that will undergo changes, but the syllabus has not yet been defined.
